RECOMMENDED COURSES FOR MAJORS PLANNING TO TRANSFER TO VWU

Students planning to transfer to Virginia Wesleyan University from anywhere within the Virginia Community College System (VCCS) should take at least one course that will satisfy VCCS general education requirements for timely degree completion. Courses in black are strongly recommended—students who do not complete these courses may require an additional year due to course sequencing issues. Courses in blue are encouraged—these are the courses that will be used to determine eligibility for the junior/senior seminar (WES 300).

Students who complete the Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will satisfy all of the VWU general education program except for the junior/senior seminar (WES 300).

VWU COURSE	VCCS EQUIVALENT
HIST 111: World History to A.D. 1600	History of Western Civilization I or History of World Civilization I.
HIST 132: World History: The Modern Era	History of Western Civilization II or History of World Civilization II
HIST 229: The Civil War and Reconstruction	God's Minute: The Winter of 1862
HIST 247: History of the U.S.	US History I and (must take both courses to fulfill HIST 247).

COURSE SEQUENCING: HIST 111 MUST BE COMPLETED BEFORE HIST 132. HIST 132 MUST BE COMPLETED BEFORE HIST 229.

Students who are not currently enrolled at a VCCS institution must take HIST 111 with a grade of "C" or better must be earned.
